Applications Accepted: May 19, 2023 – July 15, 2023

Eligibility

Members in Good Standing from PSRFCU, sons and daughters of members in good standing; who have applied to or have been accepted to an accredited institution.

Qualifications

A 2-3 page, double spaced essay discussing the following:

1. Your higher education goals, why you chose them and the estimated income for your future career choice.
2. Describe the value of saving, the time value of money, how to use leverage in financial terms, student loan debt and the effects of COVID on education, investing or another financial term or lesson not listed here.
3. Ideas on how and what you would like to see our credit union provide to its members and/or one thing you learned on our website that you didn't know before.

Tips: Answer all questions, research the subject and provide facts, (please do not only use Wikipedia as it may contain undocumented facts); spelling, grammar and punctuation will be evaluated.

Please email or deliver to PSRFCU the following along with your essay:

- Name, address, phone, email
- Current transcripts
- Application letter or letter of acceptance to an accredited institution
- How long you have been a member (or relative has been a member)
- 2 letters of recommendation (non-family) with examples of teamwork, reliability and accountability.
